# **MILESTONE MOMENTS**

#### **LAUNCH DAY** 3/21/2023

The day we set our eyes on a more equitable and empowered future. We shared our mission with teens, moms, and community leaders in San Diego's South Bay region and celebrated March 21 as the Alex Morgan Foundation Day, as declared by the County of San Diego.



#### **MOTHER'S DAY** 5/8/2023

This Mother's Day we gave our first cash grant of \$20,000 to Casa Familiar's Promotora program, supporting the moms of San Ysidro who do critical community outreach. We also teamed up with Nike to give 45 Essentials Kits to new moms at Rady Children's Hospital and San Ysidro Health Center.



### 10/3/2023

#### **VISIT TO RADY CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL**

Alex and the foundation visited with kids, families, and staff at Rady Children's Hospital to learn more about the incredible programs at Rady Children's and how the foundation can help support families during critical times.



## 10/19/2023 **USD VS CAL WOMEN'S GAME & PLAYER PANEL**

We welcomed 25 middle- and high-school soccer players from Let's Go South Bay! and the Sweetwater Union High School District to attend a USD vs CAL women's soccer game, followed by a post-game panel where the players talked teamwork and resilience on and off the field.



#### 11/11/2023

#### **NIKE FC SOCCER CLINIC**

We invited 120 girls to a Nike FC soccer clinic, where they received instruction from an all-women's coaching staff, a custom sports bra fitting, and new gear to take home. After the clinic, the girls visited Snapdragon stadium for on-field warm-ups, watched the NWSL Championship game, and enjoyed a surprise visit with Alex.

We know the powerful effect soccer can have on girls, and Let's Go South Bay! ensures more have that opportunity. We funded their first-ever Soccer Empowerment Camp, helping 53 girls enhance their soccer skills and learn about teamwork, confidence, and mental health.

### Rady Children's Hospital

Rady Children's Hospital has been a leading voice in children's health since their start in 1954. We launched a partnership to help fund the comprehensive care of children and their families at Rady Children's and, together, raise the next generation of healthy, confident kids.



#### **Girl Effect**

We know the playing field isn't always equal, especially for girls. Girl Effect leverages media and tech to unlock the power and potential of girls everywhere. Together, we launched "In the Field," amplifying the voices of young female changemakers around the world.



#### **TranscenDANCE**

Confidence through creativity. TranscenDANCE is a nationally-recognized organization that works with youth in San Diego's under-resourced communities to foster self-expression through the arts. This year, we covered the costs to install a new dance floor at their second facility.



# ALEX'S HOMEBREAK

At every home game for the San Diego Wave, a pink banner that reads 'Alex's Homebreak' proudly marks the section where youth girls' soccer teams attend games and find inspiration to make waves of their own. This year we hosted 13 teams across San Diego County and contributed funds toward supplies and transportation to help keep girls playing.
